## STANDING RULES

The following provides the standing rules from the Second District (2D) Membership Selection Committee (MSC). These standing rules are best practices and necessary to promote clarity and consistency for a 2D “MSP Virtual Training” MVT session.

- Ω Attendance – Log-in and remain for the duration of the training session. Recommended to join 10 to 15 minutes prior to the start time to ensure connection and resolve issues.
- Ω Camera – Establish and remain visible to MSC on camera for the duration of the training. Visible includes your full face and proper lighting thereon. Partial views, shadows and sitting too far back can present visibility issues resulting in removal.
- Ω Communication – Monitor the Chat for communications that may provide important instructions that may allow you to correct deficiencies. If deficiencies are not addressed in due order and time, you may be removed from the session.
- Ω Connection – Ensure a sound wi-fi connection and sufficient power for your device. (e.g., cell phone, desktop, laptop, tablet). Note that the MVT is not intended as an *in-and-out* nor *off-and-on* attendance where one may enter, separate and return. Disruption associated with 2D will be addressed as a 2D matter with appropriate relief provided to those impacted.
- Ω Identification (ID) – Provide your *First Name* and *Last Name*; mandatory. Middle initials are optional and applicable suffices (e.g., II, III, Jr., Sr.) are optional, but encouraged to distinguish between relatives. Set your ID on your device prior to joining the session. DO NOT use all caps nor titles (e.g., Bro., Dr.) nor your Frat tag.
- Ω Location – Ensure an appropriate stationary location during the session and wear appropriate attire. The session is not appropriate to attend while otherwise engaged, such as walking around in the home or office pre-occupied, sitting in a barbershop chair, ordering at a fast-food counter or dining out, nor driving. Please observe the importance of this MSP training with appropriate time and attention.
